**II. Approval of March 21, 2023 Meeting Minutes**

**III. IDOT Bicycle Facility Inventory System**

Wendy Sheppard from IDOT presented the new statewide Bicycle Facility Inventory System, which includes an online interactive map database with information about bicycle lanes, paths, trails and their associated characteristic. An invitation was sent to all communities that were interested following the presentations so they could make contributions to the interactive map.

**IV. NWMC Bike Field Trip**

Staff presented two possible summer bike-ped field trip locations in Glenview and Hoffman Estates. After some discussion from the committee it was decided

that a poll would be sent out to determine between the two locations to be announced at the May 16<sup>th</sup> meeting.

**V. Local Project Updates**

Mr. Baxa informed the committee that Northbrook will be hosting an open house for their Walters Ave concept corridor project that will cover the potential project alignments.

Ald. Sanoica announced that Rolling Meadows had received CMAQ funding for a bike path at Hartung Rd and Quentin Rd that will connect Harper College to other residential areas.

Ms. Beckner announced that Mount Prospect had received \$3 million in ITEP funding for their Melas-Meadows Pedestrian Bridge project.

Mr. Reynolds announced that Lincolnwood had received \$2.95 million in ITEP funding for their Pratt Ave project.
